

9. Czech New Energies Rallye FIA E-Rally Regularity Cup Český Krumlov, 21. - 22. 5. 2021



HYGIENE AND EPIDEMIOLOGICAL CONDITIONS for participants of the 9th Czech New Energies Rally 2021

The Regional Hygiene Station of the South Bohemia Region has set the following anti-epidemic measures for the 9th Czech New Energies Rallye on 20-22 May 2021:

- Participation is possible only in case of a negative result of an antigen test performed at the sampling point in Český Krumlov before the start of the event, or a PCR test performed anywhere with a negative result not older than 72 hours.
- 2. Persons who have been vaccinated with the COVID-19 vaccine and more than 14 days have elapsed since the second dose was given, or who have had COVID-19 disease and have medical confirmation of a positive PCR test result no older than 90 days, are not required to be tested.
- 3. In places with a higher concentration of people, it is necessary to keep a minimum of 2 metres between participants, to keep the mouth and nose covered with a FFP2 / KN95 respirator (respirators will be distributed by the organiser) and to use hand sanitizer. These conditions do not apply to persons in the same vehicle when driving along the rally route.
- 4. The common catering of participants provided by the organizer will take place only in open areas of the front gardens or party tents during the event.

SAMPLING PLACE

Testing of all participants, i.e. crew members, their support staff, officials, organizers and members of the media, for the presence of SARS-CoV-2 virus by antigenic or PCR method will be carried out at the sampling point in the building of the Historical Brewery Český Krumlov just before the start of the event.

Antigen tests are covered by public health insurance for insured persons in the Czech Republic. The insurance company reimburses the antigen test every third day. If participants take the last antigen test paid by the insurance company on Monday, May 17, the one on Thursday will be free of charge. If they take the last insurance-covered test on Tuesday or Wednesday, they will not be reimbursed and will become self-payers. If the participants arrive in Český Krumlov on Friday morning, they can take the last test paid by the insurance company on Tuesday. Self-payers or foreign participants must pay the event organiser CZK 350 (EUR 14) for the antigen test or CZK 1750 (EUR 70) for the PCR test.

On the basis of a negative result, the tested persons will receive a certified certificate by email, which they will present to the event organizer upon request before entering the common areas.

TESTING

Before the event, register at <u>www.covid-ghc.com</u>, select "BASIC ANTIGEN TEST" and "External consumption" before submitting the form. Upon registration, you will receive a SMS and email with the code GHC000XXXX. After arriving in Český Krumlov, visit the sampling point in Formanka, located in the Historical Brewery building in Pivovarská Street (<u>www.mapy.cz/s/rajakavapu</u>), tell the operator the code for the test obtained after online registration and get tested by a health care professional with a non-invasive swab from the front of the nose. You will then receive a confirmation in your email inbox, which will allow you to participate in the 9th Czech New Energies Rallye.

DATES OF SAMPLING

In order to comply with the event schedule, it is necessary to arrive at the sampling point on time for testing. If you want to attend the social event downtown on Thursday, May 20 at 7:30 p.m., arrive for the test anytime before 6:30 p.m. Keep in mind, however, that if the majority of participants arrive just before this time, there will be a line at the site and there may be a delay in sending results.

Testing for participants who are unable to test on Thursday will take place on Friday, May 21, from 7:30 to 9:00 a.m. at the same location. In the event of a late arrival, it cannot be guaranteed that the participant will receive the test result before the end of the administrative checks and therefore will not be able to start the rally. For the smooth running of the event, we would appreciate it if you could inform us in advance of your expected arrival time.

CERTIFICATES AND CONFIRMATIONS

Persons who have been vaccinated with the COVID-19 vaccine and more than 14 days have elapsed since the second dose was given, or who have had COVID-19 and have a medical certificate with a positive PCR test result no older than 90 days, are not required to be tested.

These participants are kindly requested to send a copy of the vaccination certificate or medical certificate of positive PCR test result in electronic format before the start of 9th Czech New Energies Rally 2021 to the e-mail address <u>info@cner.cz</u>.
